MED108 Certified Home Health Aide 2

The Certified Home Health Aide course is designed to provide the student with basic care skills for families with unique health needs. The student will learn the goals of maintaining basic human needs, home management, nutrition, meal planning, adapting basic care activities, observing client's medication, and special needs, as well as special procedures in emergency care.

After successful completion of the class, students will be given the state test at the Iola or Burlingame Campus. Students who pass the state test with a minimum score of 73% will be issued a Certified HHA License from the State of Kansas Department of Health and Environment.

The student must be a Certified Nurse Aide with a Kansas certificate who can provide verification of certification.
